


Lion and Elephant and Giraffe walked a long way together. Finally, they came to a very large grove of banana trees.

The two animals made a very big sound, but the monkeys were not frightened.


"Oo-oo-eee! Oo-oo-eee!" cried the monkeys.

"Oo-oo-eee! Oo-oo-eee!" cried the monkeys.




One day, Lion was walking through the jungle.
