

Grandma Van's Magic Duplicating Gel



- 1. Put one tablespoon of cornstarch in a one quart microwavable bowl.
- 2. Add one tablespoon of cold water. Stir well.
- 3. Add two-thirds cup of cold water. Stir well.
- 4. Microwave for thirty seconds. Stir.
- 5. Microwave for thirty more seconds. Stir.
- 6. Microwave for thirty MORE seconds. Stir.
- 7. If mixture is not thickened and slightly bubbly, microwave for thirty more seconds. Stir.
- 8. Allow to cool.




While the duplicating gel cooled,


