COLOR MEMORY

Game material:

- Game board with 2 circles of holes, 24 holes in total.
- 24 game pieces (6 color groups with 4 pieces each: red, green, yellow, blue, white, black)
- One 6-color dice (red, green, yellow, blue, white, black)

Rules of the game:

Up to 6 players can take part. There are several ways to play the game:

The winner is:

- the player who has the most stones at the end of the game.
- the player who is the first to collect one tile of each of the 6 colors.
- the player who is the first to have all 4 tiles of the same color.

Before the game begins, the players agree on one of these game options. If the tiles are not in the holes, they can be placed in the holes by a neutral person or by the players together before the game begins.

The youngest player begins to roll the dice and rolls ... a color. He may then remove one of the 24 pieces from the game board. If the color of the removed tile matches the color rolled, he may keep the tile and roll the dice again. If the colors still match, the player may roll the dice again and so on. If this is not the case, he must put the token back in the same place on the board and it is the next player's turn (clockwise).

If there are only a few tiles left on the playing field towards the end of the game and all players know that some colors are no longer in play, a tile must be pulled and put back after each dice roll (even with the knowledge that the rolled color can no longer be among the tiles on the playing field).
