
Light Up Clock Instructions




Component Explanations

Component	<u>Explanation</u>
"Display On/Off"	Toggling the pushbutton "in" turns the clock time display on and "out" turns it off
"Mini-USB"	The Mini-USB input is used for power and programming the Arduino Nano with a Mini-USB cable (included)
"DC Power 7-24v"	The DC Power input can be used for power input with a DC Barrel Plug 5.5mm/2.1mm 9-12V at 2A (not included)
"Display"	The 4-digit seven segment display shows the clock time when the display is turned on; also used for menu options
"-" (Minus)	Used in menu options to change time and color alarm settings
"+" (Plus)	Used in menu options to change time and color alarm settings
"Menu"	Pushing the menu button toggles through menu options and settings for clock

Menu Options

Pressing "Menu" brings you into the menu options and pressing "Menu" again takes you to the next setting in order (as shown by the arrows)
