# Joie Jellyfish

#### Material

- ★ 2 mm crochet hook
- 1 ball of dark blue yarn (here I used:
  DMC Natura Just Cotton 27 Star Light
- ★ Fibber fill for stuffing
- ★ Beads (64)
- ★ Black felt for making the eyes
- \* Yarn needle

Finished Size: Height: 9cm, width: 2.5cm

## Terminology

- ★ Rds: rounds
- ★ Sc: single crochet
- \* Ch: chain
- ★ Inc: increase
- ⋆ Dec: decrease
- ★ BLO: Back loops only
- ⋆ FO: Fasten off

### Instructions

#### Head

If you want to make as a key ring, leave enough yarn before to start. When you hide the yarn, just create a loop coming-out the top of the head.

- 1. Ch 2. 6 Sc in second Ch from the hook (6) (or 6 sc in a magic ring)
- 2. inc x6 (12)
- 3. 1 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 1sc, inc (17)
- 4. 2 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 2 sc (21)
- 5. 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 3 sc (24)
- 6. 10 sc, inc, 13 sc (25)
- 7. sc around (25)
- 8. 13 sc, dec, 10 sc (24)
- 9.3 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 3 sc (21)
- 10. 2 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 2 sc (17)
- 11. dec, 1sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 1sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 1 sc (12) Stuff
- 12. dec around (6)

#### Tentacles (make 3)

#### \* Small tentacles (make 2)

- 1.27 ch.
- 2. Insert hook into the  $2^{nd}$  stitch from hook and inc BLO into the next 18 stitches along the chain
- 3. for the last 8 ch: (1 sc, inc) x4

#### **★ Long tentacle (make 1)**

- 1.32 ch.
- 2. Insert hook into the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch from hook and inc BLO into the next 20 stitches along the chain
- 3. For the last 10 ch: (1 sc, inc) x5, 1 sc

#### Beaded threads (make 5)

Before you start to crochet, you have to thread the corresponding quantity of beads on the yarn. You can put a little of glue to make it easier, pay attention to your fingers!!

#### ★ Chains with 8 beads (make 3)

(1 ch with a bead, 2 ch without a bead) x8, 2 ch (26 ch) FO, hide the yarn

#### ★ Chains with 20 beads (make 2)

(2 ch with a bead, 1 ch without a bead) x10, 2 ch (32 ch). FO, hide the yarn

#### Attach the parts

Start by the 2 'chains with 20 beads' in the center of the head (the end of the crocheted head), then sew the 3 'chains with 8 beads'. Finish by attaching the tentacles around the beaded threads.

#### The eyes

To finish, cut out 2 very small rounds in the black felt and glue this eyes to the head. You can add 2 very small dots with white paint on the eyes to obtain a cutest look.
