

Name	Function
CTR-ALT-T	Open terminal
CTR-C	Cancel commands
pwd	List directory
ls	List sub-directories
ls -la	List hidden sub-directories
clear	Clears the terminal screen.
cd (example: cd Downloads)	Change directory
cd..	Moves back to previous directory
touch file.txt	Creates text file
rm (example: rm file.txt)	Removes file or program
mkdir (example: mkdir Pictures)	Makes directory
whoami	Displays current user
uptime	Displays time spent on machine
nano (example: nano word.txt)	Creates a program or text file
cat (example: cat word.txt)	Lists all text in a file
grep (example: cat word.txt grep password)	Search for specific term in a file, in the example it would search for password in word.txt
echo (example: echo hello > word.txt)	Adds word to file without opening it, in example it would add hello to word.txt
history	Displays all commands entered
cp	Copy file
mv	Move file
locate (example: locate program.py)	Locate files
shutdown	Shutdown
shutdown -c	Cancel shutdown
top	All processes and specs of CPU usage
uname	Name of operating system
Uname -a	Full name and version
ifconfig	List Ip addresses
netstat	Info on router
netstat -nr	Find router Ip address
sudo -s	Change to root user
sudo apt-get install (example: sudo apt-get install tor)	Installs programs
tillix	Opens multiple terminal tabs (must be installed first)
macchanger	Displays macchanger options
whois (example: whois google.com)	Displays server's info on websites, registry and location
service tor start	Starts tor
Service tor stop	Stops tor
