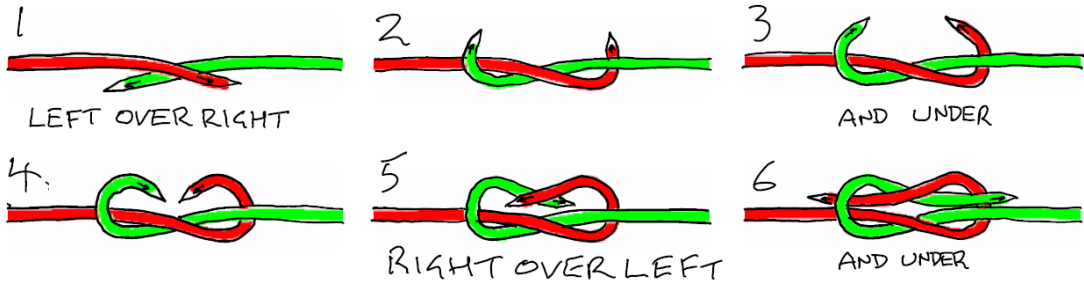


CUB SCOUT KNOTS

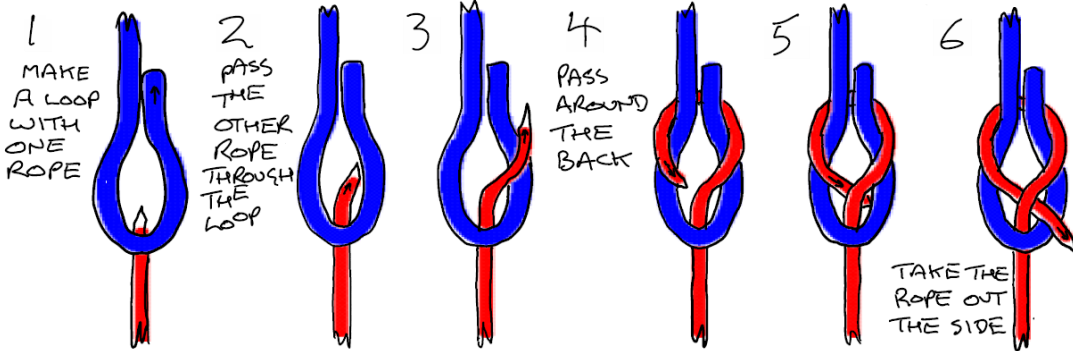
Reef Knot

Boomerang's: Bronze, Silver and Gold
Purpose: To join two ropes together.



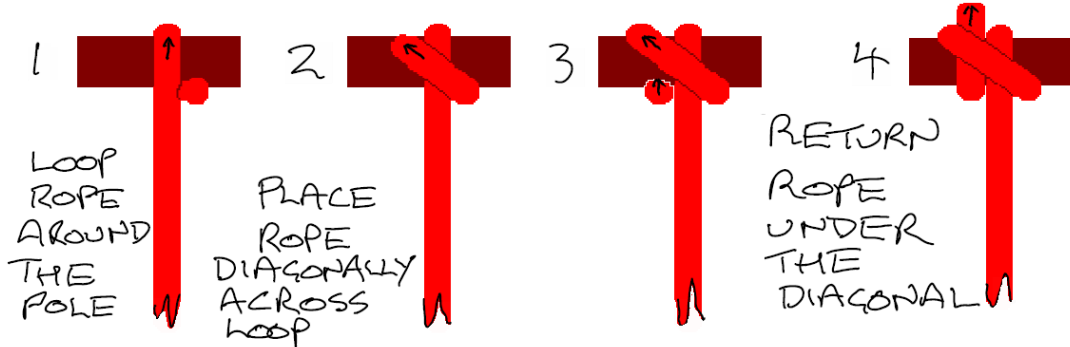
Sheet Bend

Purpose: To join two different sized ropes together.



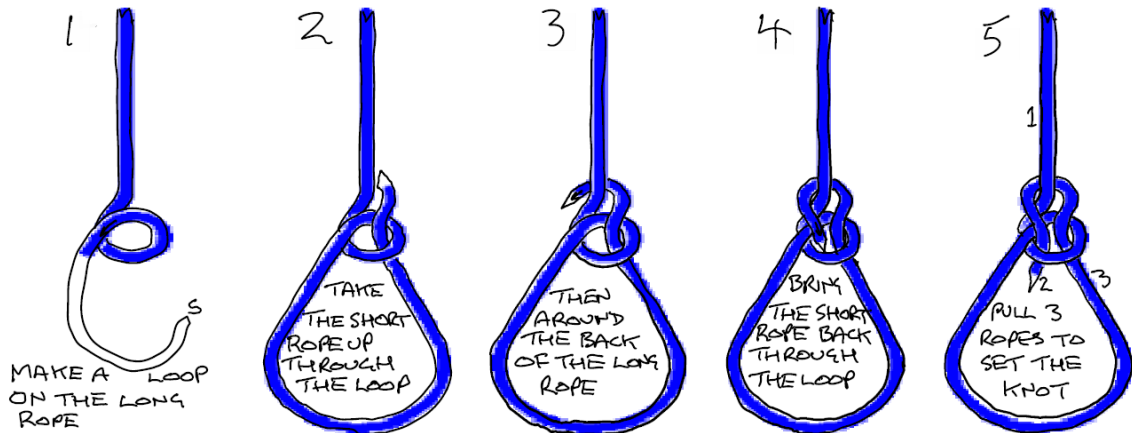
Clove Hitch

Boomerang's: Bronze and Silver
Purpose: To start and finish a lashing.



Bowline

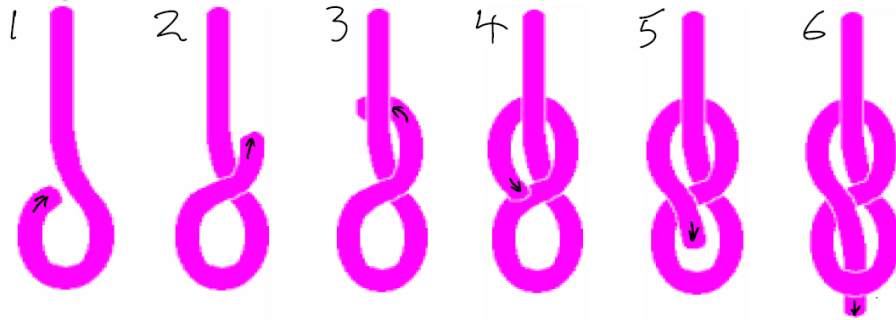
Boomerang: Gold
Purpose: Is used to make a loop at one end of a rope.



ADVANCED KNOTS

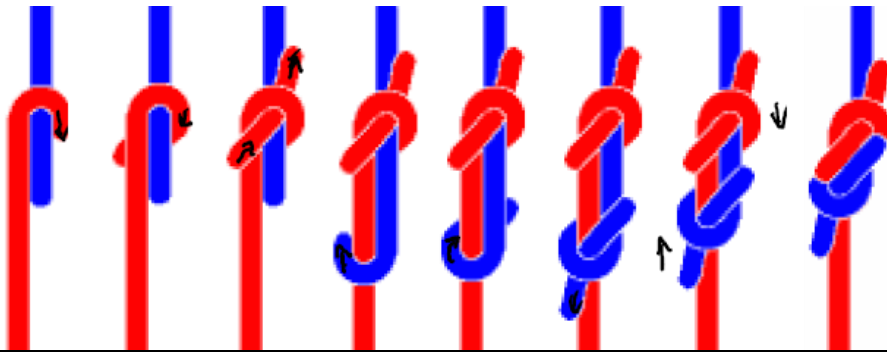
Figure of Eight

Purpose: It is very important in both sailing and rock climbing as a method of stopping ropes from running out of retaining devices.



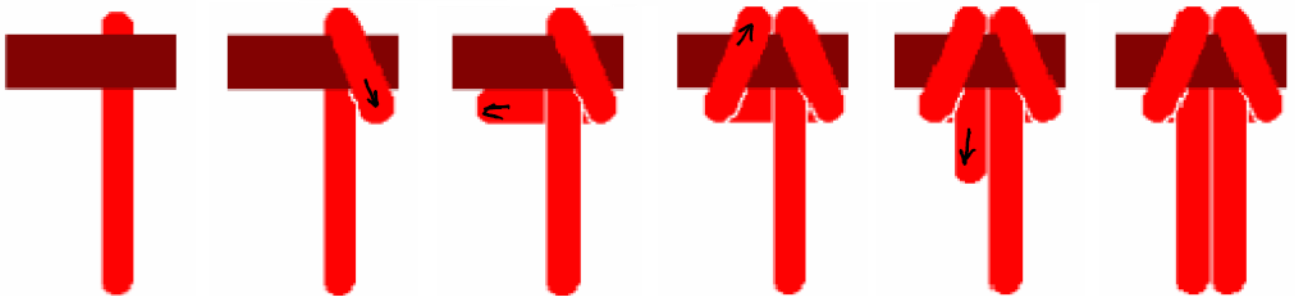
Fisherman's Knot

Purpose: The fisherman's knot is associated with fishing, it can slip when tied in nylon monofilament and other slippery lines.
