

This Mighty ToolBox will do just the job for holding all your important tools.

We created our Mighty ToolBox out of cardboard and other recycled materials from around the home, along with Makedo parts available at mymakedo.com.

· Find · Cut · Connect ·



1 Gather your materials. For this toolbox you will need a long card roll (cling wrap or similar), some cardboard and a rectangular box that is roughly the same length as your card roll. Make sure you have your Makedo tools handy.



2 Shape the top flaps and remove any excess card you don't need.



3 Use two Makedo Re-clips to reinforce the base. This will stop your tools and goodies falling out the bottom when you lift the ToolBox up!

· Connect · Join · Measure ·



4 Use your Makedo Safe-saw to poke holes through each end of the tube and attach a hinge on either side. Slide the hinge lock into place.



5 Attach the other side of the hinge to the top flaps of the box.



6 Use the scrap cardboard to make a divider. Draw around the side of your ToolBox to ensure the square is the right size. Using a Makedo Re-clip to measure, draw two tabs on the sides of the square.

7 Use four Makedo Re-clips to secure the divider inside your ToolBox.
