




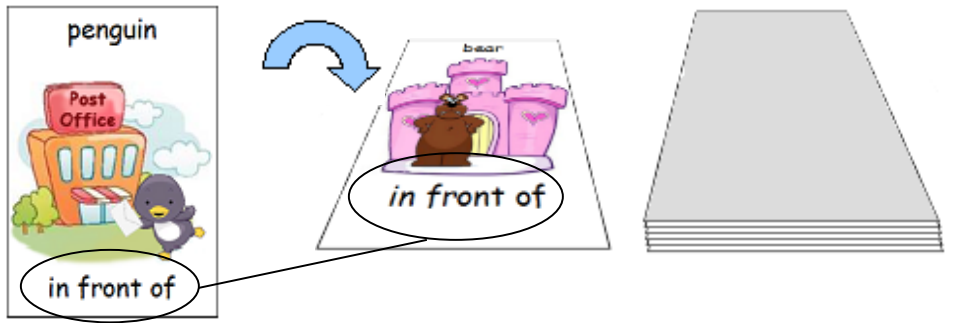


Where is it? Card Game

How to Play:	
1. Make groups of 3 or 4 players.	
2. Give 8 cards to each player.	
3. Put the rest of the cards face down in the middle of the table.	
4. Play goes clockwise.	
5. Decide who goes first.	Rock, paper, scissors!
6. Flip over the top card and put it face up in the middle of the table.	

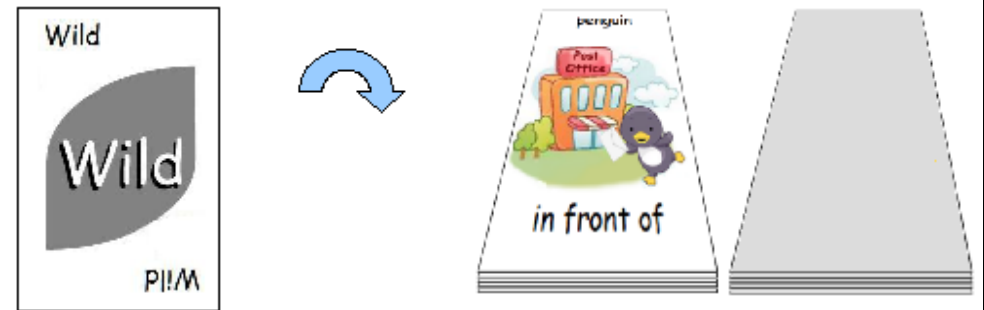
7. The first player will play one card that matches the animal or the position. The student will make a sentence with the words on the card. For example, "The penguin is in front of the post office."



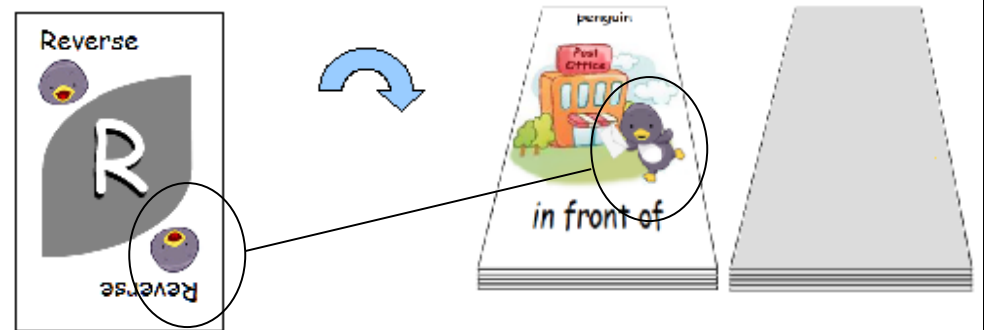
8. The next player will play a card that will match one of the words on the previous card. For example, "The penguin is on the ball," or "The cat is in front of the TV."



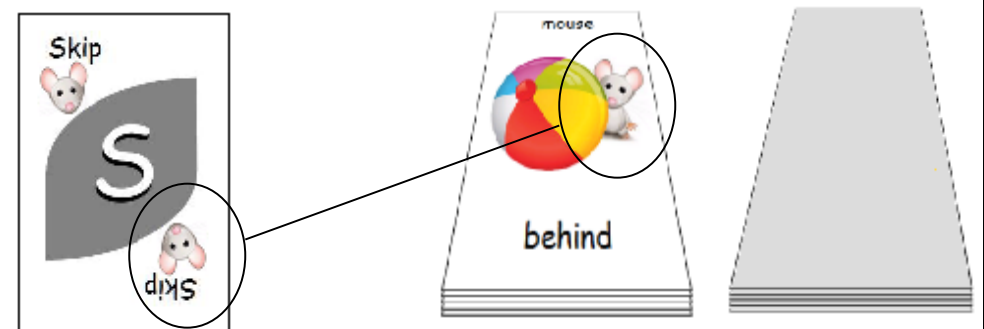
9. You can play "Wild" cards on any card. You can choose the animal for the next player to play.



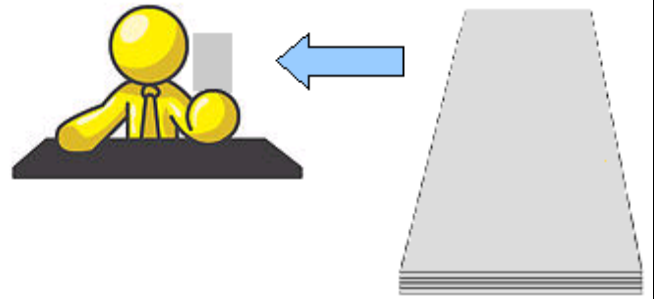
10. "Reverse" cards must match the animal played before. "Reverse" means that the order of players changes (goes backwards).



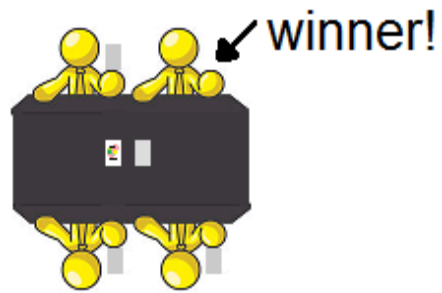
11. "Skip" cards must match the animal played before. "Skip" means that the next player misses a turn.



12. If a student cannot play, the student will take one card from the pile. If the new card can be played, he/she can play it in this turn.



13. The student who gets rid of all of his/her cards first is the winner!
