MAGNETIC MAGIC GENIE IN A BOTTLE

You can use the templates to create your genie, Or you can design your own! Use the blank to design at will, the template to color in, or use the printed version. If you bottle is large, you may want to resize the genie to fit perfectly.

- 1. Choose an empty clean recycled jar and decide how large you would like your genie. Resize your genie if needed and print the template.
- 2. Color in your genie at will using pens, crayons markers, pencils or a combination of.
- Cut the genie out and fold along the dotted lines, color outside.
- 4. Tape one magnet to the the opposite side of the "O".
- 5. Perhaps you want to add some glitter or sparkle elements with glue, or sticky rhinestones to add more details.
- **6.** Glue the genie together on the non-colored inside side to close it around the magnet. See guide as to how to glue to the right glueing "A" to "B".
- **7.** Attach the additional magnet to the top of the genie. Remember opposite sides of the magnet attract! The two magnets will stick together. This will allow you to know what side you need to place down on top of the lid to make you genie fly around the jar!
- 8. Now that you know the correct sides of the magnets to use, detach them. Place your genie, magnet side up to the inside of the jar. I would use the bottom of the jar as the TOP, as you will see your genie much better when it is moving. Place the second magnet outside the jar, this will make your genie attach to the using magnetic force.
- **9.** Close the lid, with the genie inside the bottle, and move the magnet on top of the jar to make your genie move like magic!
- 10. You can embellish magnet on the top of the jar as you like! Perhaps add a creative topper to the magnet to make it stand out!
- 11. Perhaps you want to decorate the genie's bottle! It is up to you to be the artist!


