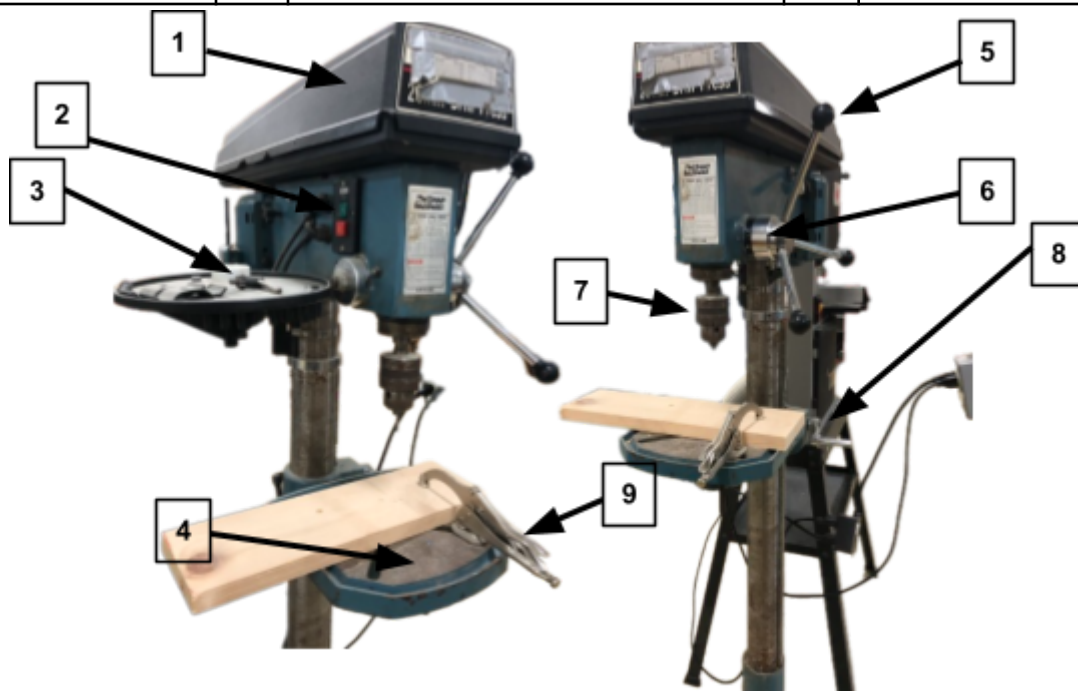


Drill Press Safety and Operations Test

Given a properly functioning drill press, accessories, instruction and demonstration of use, each student will be able to: Identify the major parts of the drill press. Pass a written test on safety and operating procedures of the drill press with 100 percent accuracy. Demonstrate ability to use the drill press, following suggested safety rules and correct operation procedures.
