YOU WILL NEED:



Paper (Colorful Construction Paper or Card Stock.)




Scissors



Conductive Tape



4 LEDs




2 Batteries



1 Paper Clip

- CUT OUT PAPER SHAPE
 Use template page to help if needed.
- 2 FOLD BOTTOM




3 APPLY CONDUCTIVE TAPE
Apply lines of tape as shown.



APPLY LEDs onto TREE


Bend LED legs.

The long LED legs go on the left side of the tree.
The short LED legs go on the right side of the tree.
Stick them down with more conductive tape.



5 STACK 2 BATTERIES

near bottom of fold. The positive side of both batteries marked "+" must face up.



6 PAPERCLIP the BATTERIES
Position paperclip vertically so that it holds batteries between fold of paper.


Your tree should light up!

If not, check~

- If none of the LEDs light up, flip the batteries and try again.
- If one of the LEDs does not light, one of two things could be the problem:
 - 1) The copper tape is not secure around the LED legs.


 Press around them and see if you can get the offending LED to light.
 - ② One of your LEDs is backwards.
 Gently peel the tape off the LED legs and switch it around.
