



"range" function creates a list using the following parameters:

START

Number to start the list

Number to stop the list [Should be **one more** than you want, ie: 101 if you want to stop at 100.]

STOP

Number that range function will increment the list by for the next number, ie: 1 [Could also be 2, 5, etc.]

Example: for number in range(1, 101, 1)

Using "**for"** loop: each number from list placed in variable "number" during every pass of the "**for"** loop Using the "**range**" function: create a list starting at "1", then increment the list by "1" for each subsequent number in list until you hit "100"
