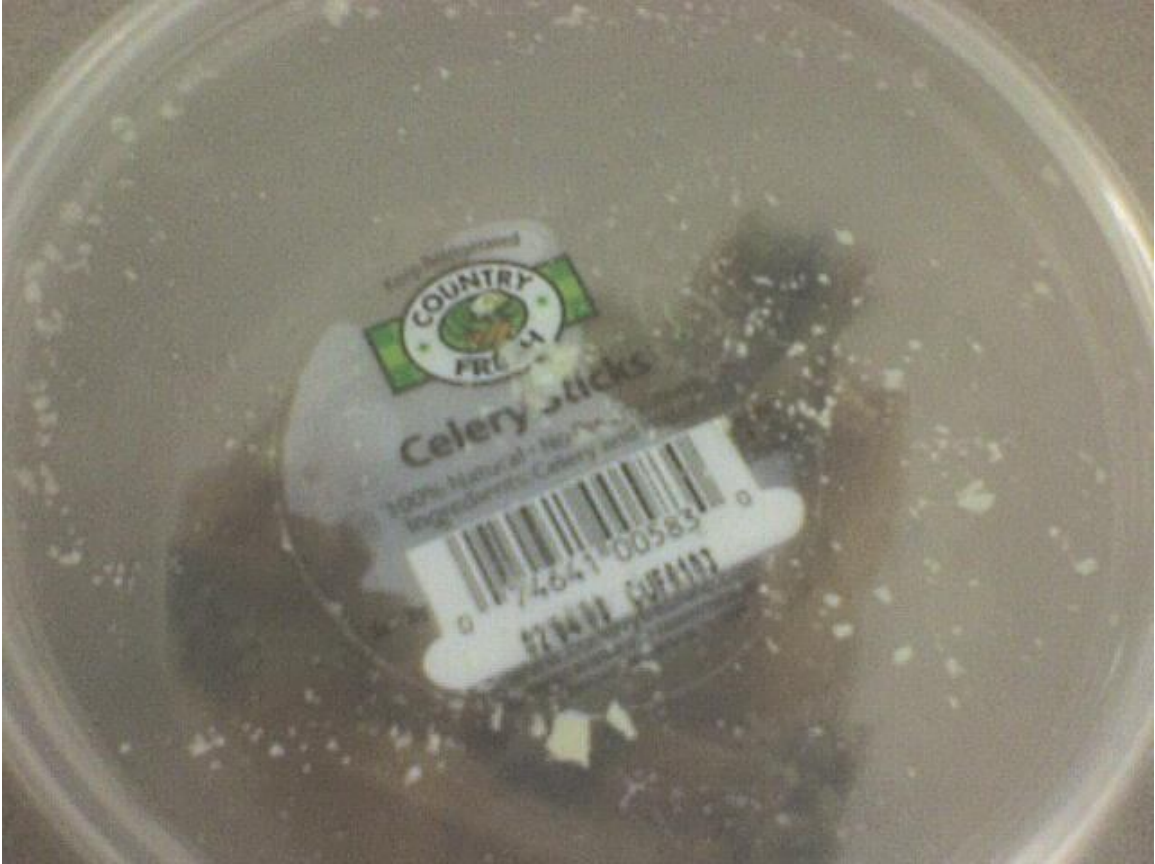
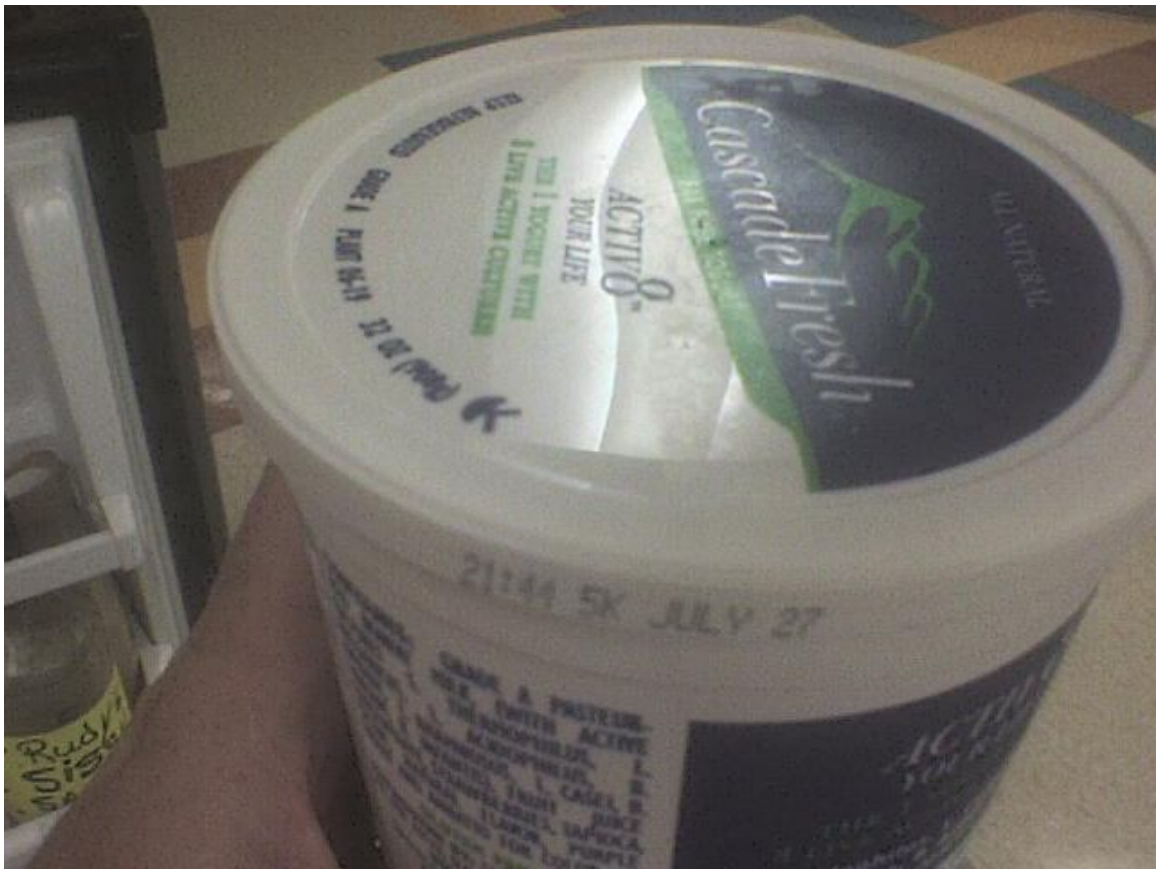


I think this is the oldest thing I found. Some sort of dressing that expired 18 months ago.



Celery sticks aren't meant to be this color (or consistency)



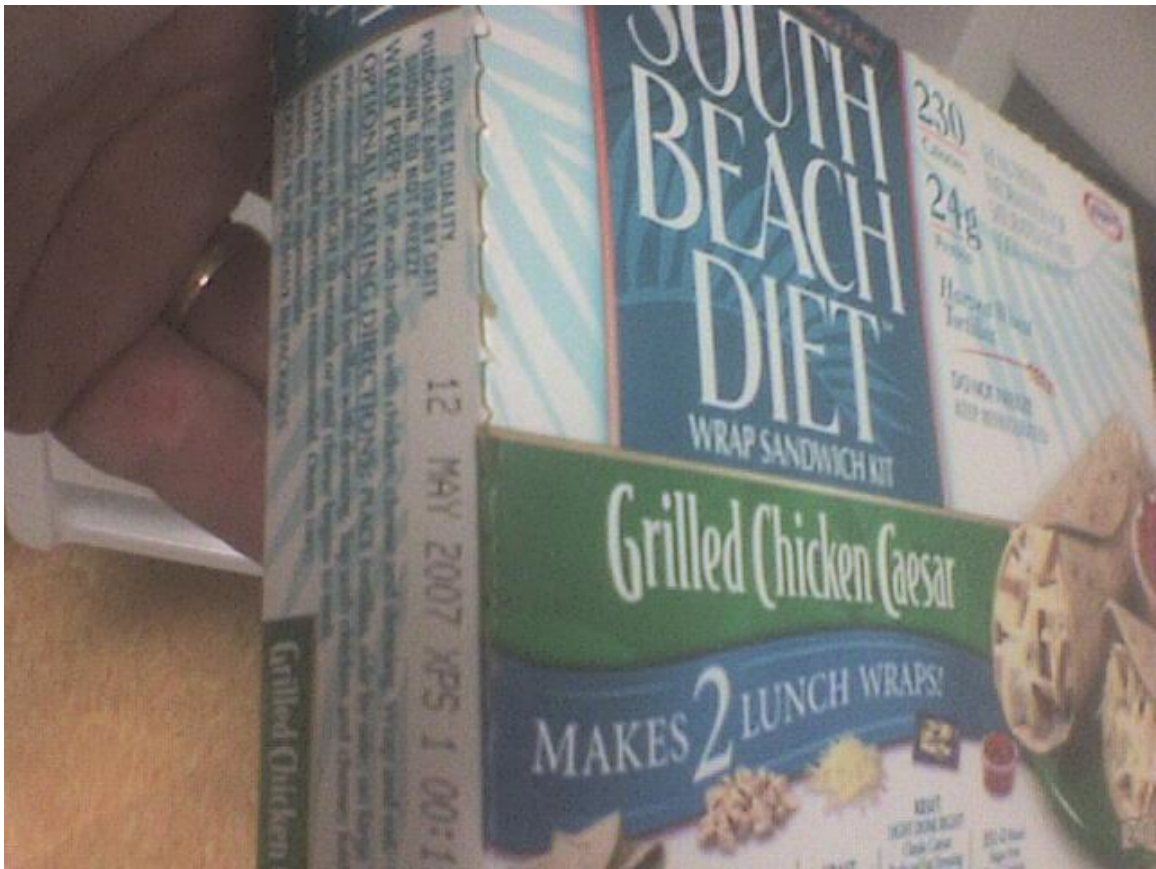
I'm pretty sure it isn't July of 08, especially since it sounded a bit 'sloshy'

The black lump in the middle didn't look much like a carrot.



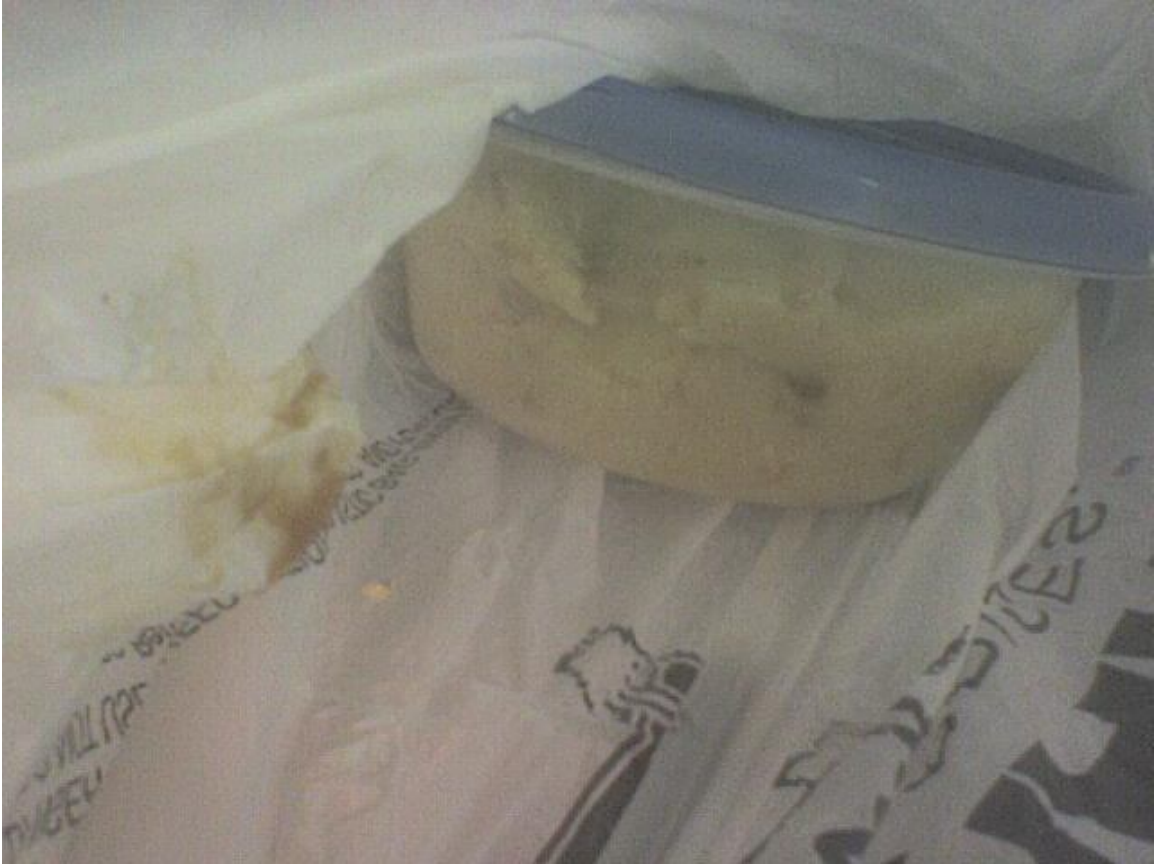
I guess the diet thing worked...



This wasn't chocolate milk, so the dark residue has me worried.



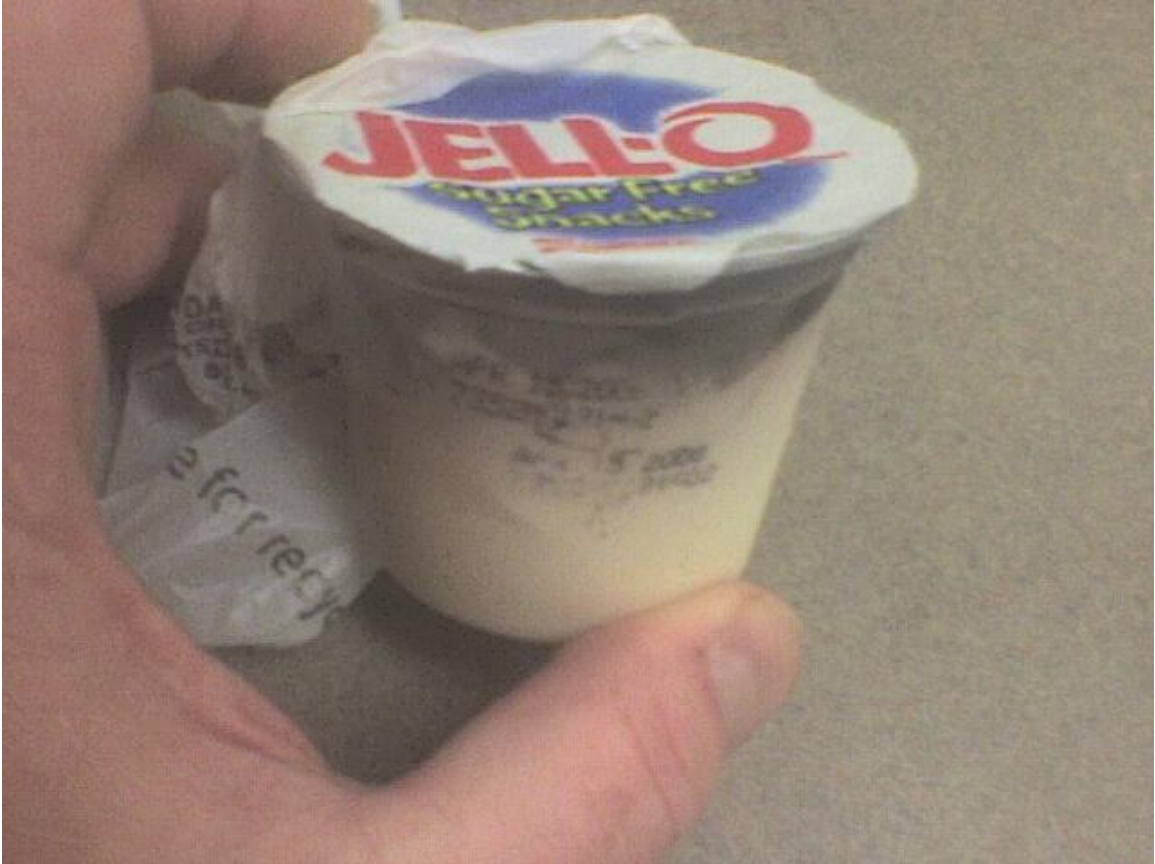
There's no date, so I'm not sure if this is the oldest or not...

What do you think the original color of the sauce was?



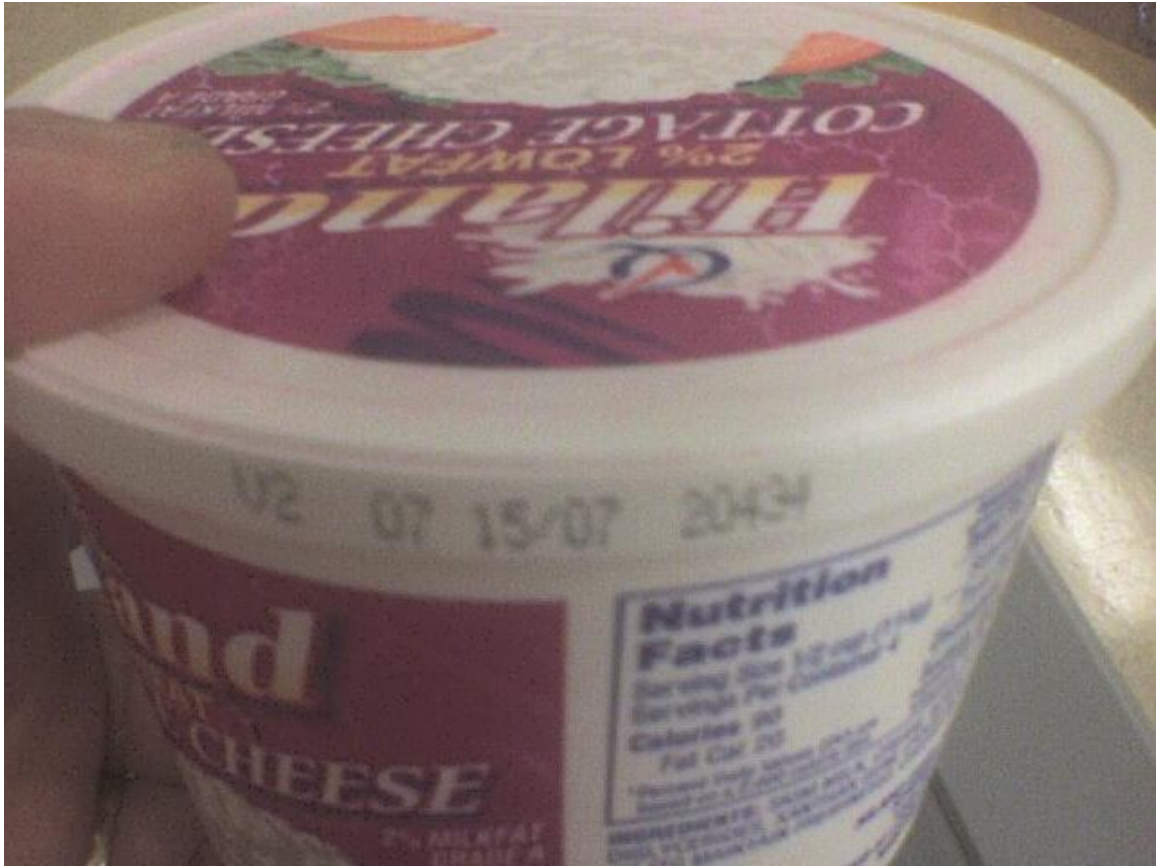
Jello isn't typically black...

It may be difficult to tell, but this apple looked like it was deflating. The bottom was flat.



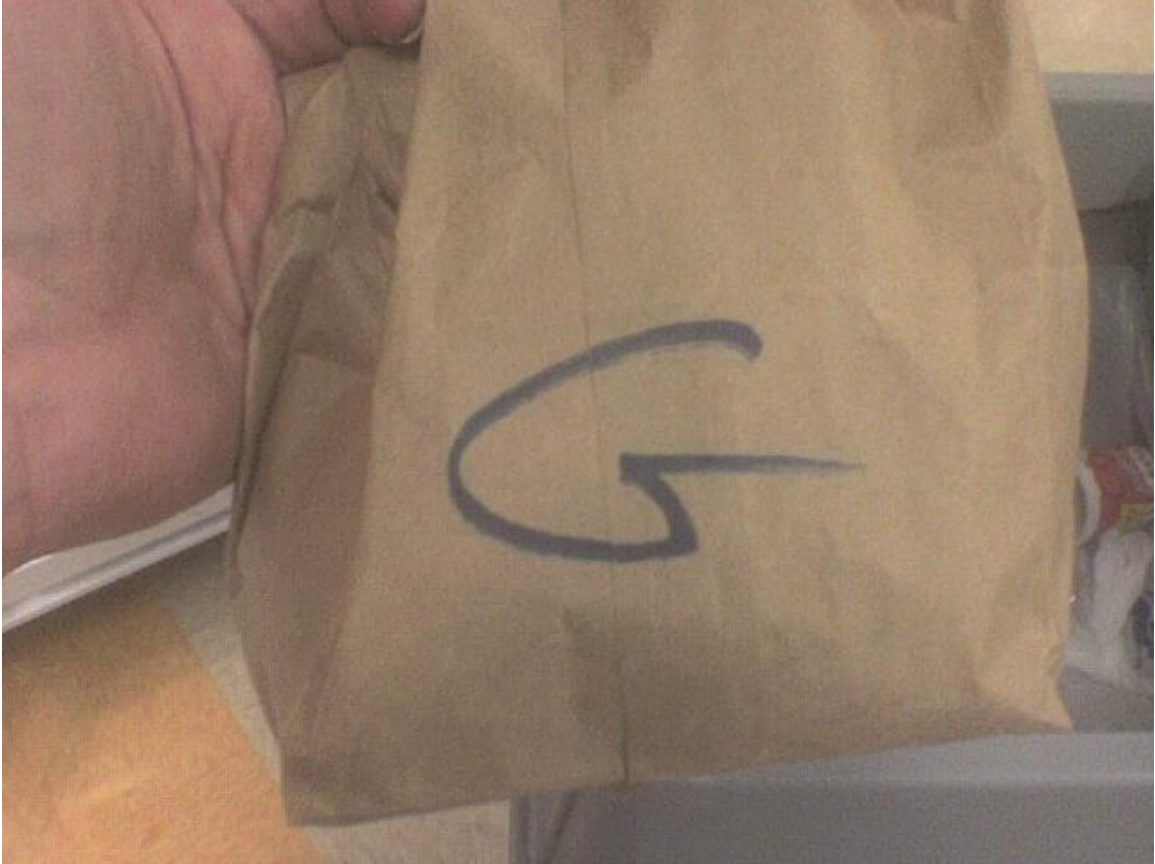
Hey, less than a year out of date!



Can't even guess....



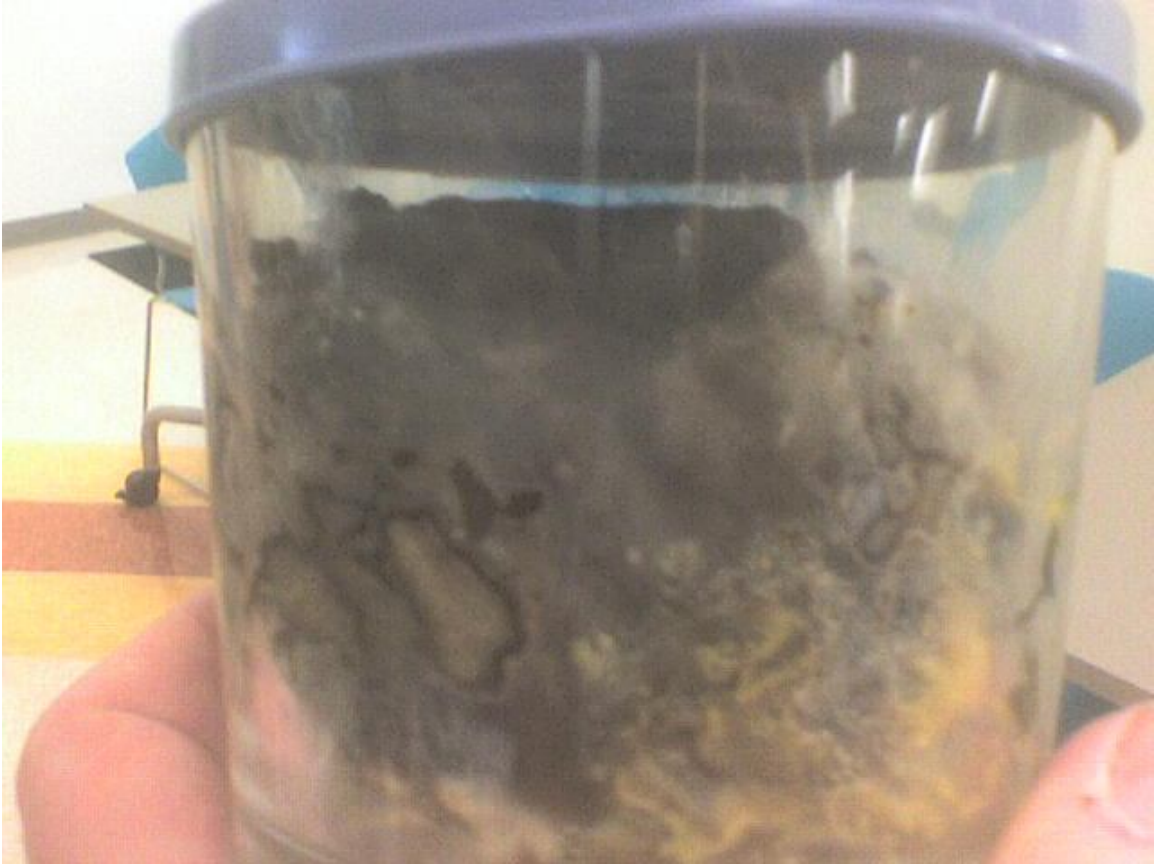
No, the reason you can't see individual leaves isn't because the picture is bad. It's that they gelled into a single mass of deep green.
