PBL: Create a Policy – FIRST STEPS

High School Policy: Per the TN Board of Education Section 5, Part E (paraphrase): All students must complete a project-based learning assessment in civics. - 3. Discuss with Mrs. H for her approval
 - a. Must be a **state** issue or a school policy
 - b. First come, first serve
 - c. No repeats
- 4. Discuss the specifics of your bill (what will it do?)
