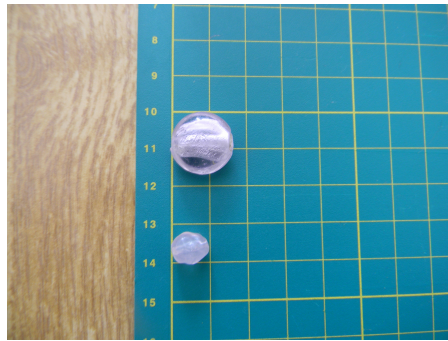


Creating spiders with beads

Get 2 beads a large one about 2cm for the body and a smaller one for the head about 1cm



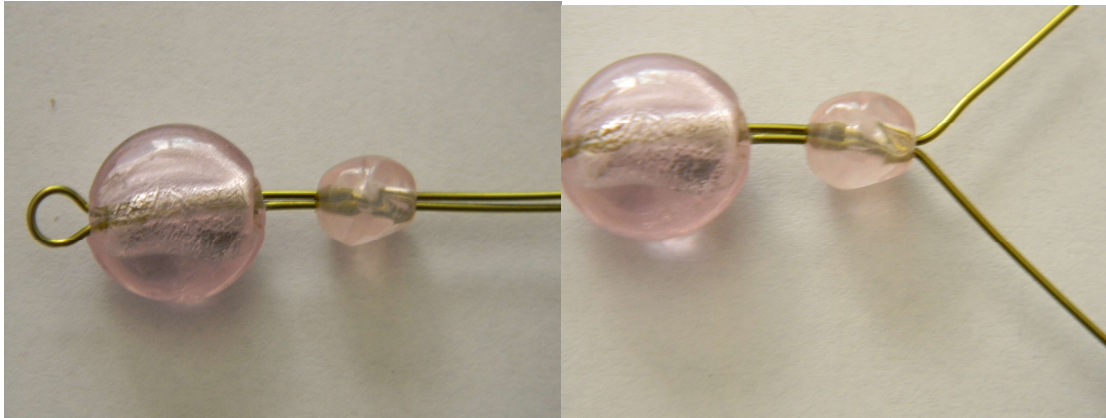
Get a piece of 20swg wire about 8cm long and make a loop in the end with a pair of round nosed pliers.



Thread the bead for the body onto the wire



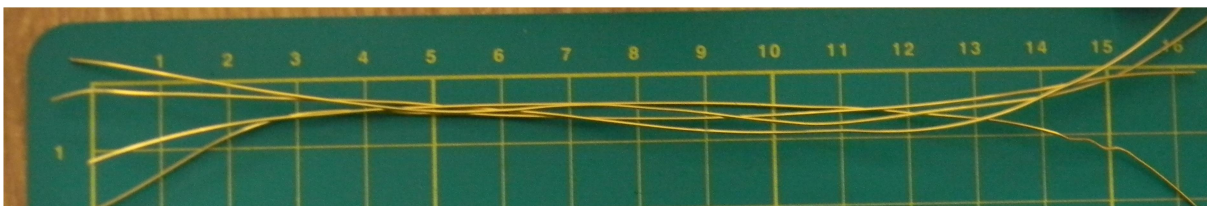
Get another piece of 20 gauge wire and push into the bead and place the head bead over both pieces of wire leaving a gap for the legs and spread the wires apart.



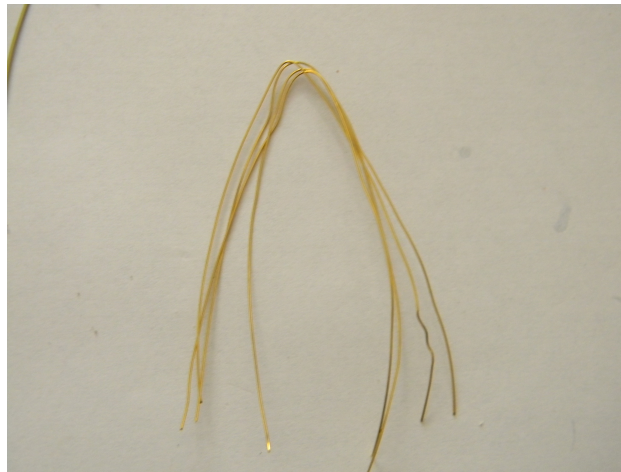
Get 2 smaller beads and place one over each wire and then cut the wire to length, seal the end of the wire to the bead with a dab of either epoxy or you can use nail varnish.



Measure 4 wires of 24swg each wire should be about 14 to 16 cm long



Bend the wires in half

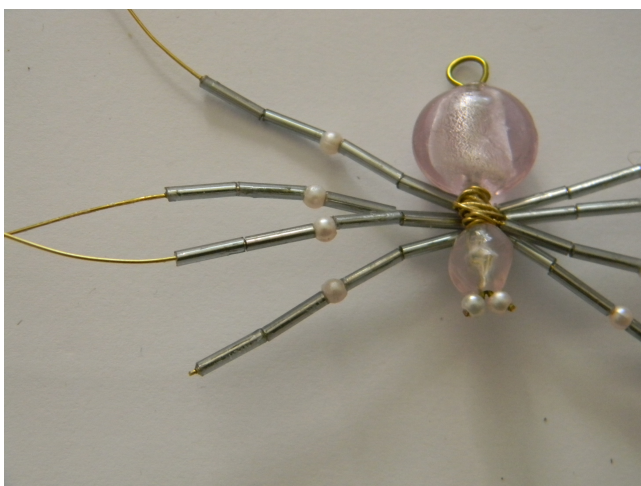


Weave the wires around the mid section to lock 4 wires each side



This is a bit untidy but if you spend a bit more time you can get a cross hatch pattern

Put 2 long beads and a bead you used for the eye onto each leg wire then put two more long beads on the legs.



Cut the leg wires to length. File the wires with a jewellery file till they are flat on the end and then seal with epoxy .
